About Phuket, Thailand

Phuket is the biggest island in Thailand, in the Andar Sea of southern Thailand. The island is mostly mountains with a mountain range in the west of the island from the north to the south. The mountains of Phuket form southern end of the Phuket mountain range, which is for 440 kilometres (270 mi) from the Kra Isthmus.

Phuket is one of the southern provinces of Thailand, consists of the Island of Phuket, the country's largest island, and another 32 smaller islands off its coast. It is off the west coast of Thailand in the Andaman Sea. Phuket Island is connected by the Sarasin Bridge to Phang Province to the north. The next nearest province is Krabi to the east across Phang Nga Bay.

Phuket Province has an area of 576 square kilometres (222 sq mi), somewhat less than that of Singapore, and the second-smallest province of Thailand. It formerly derived its wealth from tin and rubber, and enjoys a rich colorful history. The island was on one of the major trade routes between India and China, and was frequently visited in foreign ship logs of Portuguese, French, Dutch and English traders. The region now derives much of its income from tourism.

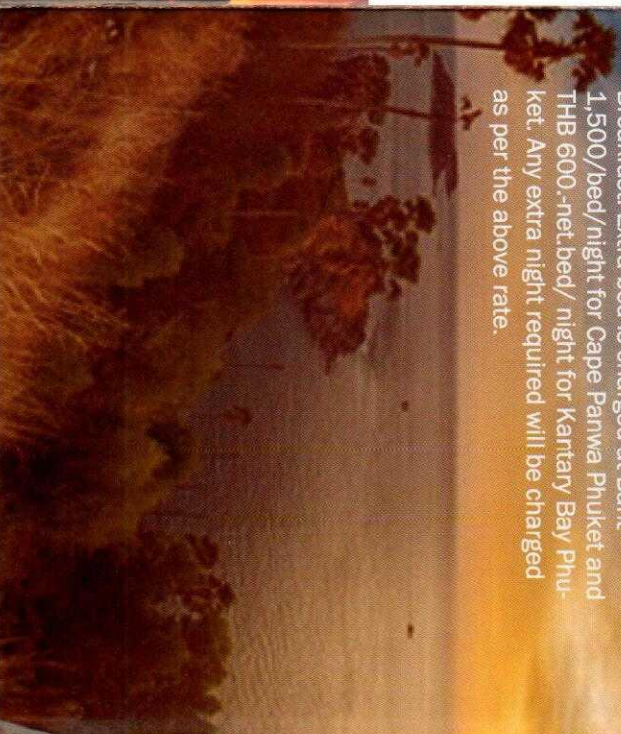
